# 1. BAGGRUND

Denne rapportering er udarbejdet på baggrund af i alt 408 gennemførte interview med udenlandske ansatte på udvalgte virksomheder i Lyngby-Taarbæk Kommune. Undersøgelsen er gennemført som en webbaseret spørgeskemaundersøgelse via mailudsendelse af unikke links til de ansatte.

Interviewene er gennemført i perioden 10. april–1. maj 2013.

I alt blev 1.496 ansatte inviteret til at deltage i undersøgelsen. Heraf endte 408 ansatte med at deltage, hvilket betyder en svarprocent på 27 %.

Det er Epinions overbevisning, at der er tale om en mere end almindelig god svarprocent for en spørgeskemaundersøgelse blandt ansatte, for hvem det ikke har været obligatorisk at deltage. Epinion vurderer endvidere, at størrelsen af den tilvejebragte sample samt dennes kvalitet er tilstrækkelig til, at undersøgelsens resultater kan siges at være

repræsentative for målgruppen af internationale medarbejdere i kommunen.

Rapporten viser undersøgelsens resultater i form af tabeller. Tabellerne viser resultaterne som procenttal, dvs. andele af de ansatte eller de respektive undergrupper af de ansatte. I nogle tilfælde kan tabellerne summere til mere end 100 %, hvilket skyldes respondentens mulighed for at afgive flere svar på det pågældende spørgsmål.

Epinion står naturligvis til rådighed i forbindelse med yderligere analyser og forespørgsler, hvis Lyngby-Taarbæk Vidensby ønsker særlige analyser inden for bestemte områder.
