

Building a new talent pipeline

The Cross-border Talent Bridge Mentor Scheme aims to attract and retain international talents in the Öresund Region and is part of the Interreg Öresund-Kattegat-Skagerrak EU program. The program aims to strengthen the supply of skilled professionals in the Life Science and Tech sectors (med-tech, food-tech, and biotech) within the Greater Copenhagen region.

The mentoring scheme is designed to support international students (graduates), professionals and their families in settling successfully in Greater Copenhagen. It builds new networks and makes it easier for companies to attract and retain international specialists.

What is it about?

You will be matched to a carefully selected highly educated international living less then 3 years in Denmark. We ask you to meet four times with your mentee during a time frame of 6 months. Meetings are mutually agreed and can take place both face-to-face and online.
